Welcome Reverend Kathryn Rívera Torea

The Pastor Nominating Committee over the past year has asked for your prayers and patience, and it has paid off! We are happy to announce that we have called Rev. Kathryn Rivera Torea to be our next full-time minister.

Pastor Katie has 17 years experience and actually started her ministry right here in our church. She was with us for a few months in 2003-04 until she accepted her first call. Some of you may remember her as Katie Rhoads.

Katie grew up in Lima and mentored under David Montgomery. Her extended family lives in Mentor, and they have a cottage at Wampler Lake in the Irish Hills. She is married to Juan Pablo, who grew up in Mexico. They have no children but do have two cats.

Katie's references were glowing: wonderful human, excellent minister, authentic, gifted in providing care, unflappable, powerful in the pulpit, strong administrative skills, high integrity, generous and funny, and passionate about ministry, mission, justice, change, and stretching the comfort zone. Based on the results of our Vital Signs Report (from the CAT survey) Katie is a perfect match for our church.

Katie has been examined by the Maumee Valley Presbytery and deemed fit to serve. She has accepted our Terms of Call, and those Terms of Call have been approved by our Session. We will have a Congregational Meeting after worship on December 5 to elect Rev. Kathryn Rivera Torea as our next minister, and to elect new Session members Class of 2024.

What a glorious way to start our holiday season with the anticipation of a new minister in 2022! Pastor Katie finishes her call in Haverstraw, NY on December 31. She and Juan Pablo will be moving to Perrysburg the first of the year. Rev. Rivera Torea's first Sunday to preach in our pulpit will be January 16, 2022.

The PNC would like to recognize Marty Sloan and the Worship & Music Team for filling our pulpit during this transition time. We are truly grateful. Well done and thank you!

First Presbyterian Church Scholarship Program Information

The First Presbyterian Church Scholarship is available for graduating high school seniors and current college students who are members of the First Presbyterian Church of Perrysburg pursuing undergraduate degree at an accredited post-secondary institution. This scholarship is renewable for 3 additional years after the initial award (4 years total), provided the student meets the renewal conditions.

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

Applications are first carefully reviewed by the Greater Toledo Community Foundation (GTCF) staff to verify their eligibility.

- 1. Must be a U.S. Citizen.
- 2. Must be a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Perrysburg (Perrysburg, Ohio).
- 3. Must have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA or higher.
- 4. Must be pursuing an undergraduate degree.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Eligible applicants are reviewed by a Scholarship Advisory Committee (SAC) based on the following criteria, in order of significance.

- 1. Academic Achievements
- 2. Positive People-Centered Character
- 3. Extracurricular Involvement
- 4. Community Service & Volunteer Involvement
- 5. Financial Need
- 6. Work Experience

SCHOLARSHIP PROCESS & TIMELINE

November	Application Available: Click here to apply on the Scholarship Portal. Within the portal, complete the GTCF General/Universal Scholarships Application.
February 11	Application Deadline: Applicants are fully responsible for uploading required documents by the deadline.
March	Review Process: SAC reviews & evaluates applications.
April	Committee Meeting: SAC meets to discuss applicants & select recipients.
May 15	Decision Notifications: GTCF notifies applicants of the Committee's decisions (approval & denial).
July 8	Follow Up: Recipients must submit a Scholarship Recipient Form prior to payment to confirm students are in compliance with the scholarship conditions.
Late July	Payments: Scholarships are paid directly to post-secondary institution (never directly to student).
