COFFEE CAKE MINISTRY: The chef has expanded the menu to include cookies. In December, a beautiful, long-time member received cut-out sugar cookies. Thank you, Eileen, for brightening her day!

GOOD SAMARITAN FUND: In December, 3 individuals received a \$25.00 gift card. One also was given two bags of groceries.

THE COCOON: Mission purchased \$240.00 of items on their "wish list". Bed linen, towels, washcloths, hygiene/cleaning products. etc.

BACKPACKS FOR HUMANS: This project for the homeless, started in July 2020, bringing humanity to the community. They meet every Sunday at Uptown Green Park, in Toledo, receiving both a meal and a backpack full of essential items. Spending \$200.00, Mission purchased 22 pairs of men's long underwear and10 combs.

SAFETY NET: Located at the Zepf Center in Toledo, it is the only shelter serving runaway and homeless teenagers in Northwest Ohio. A \$300.00 cash donation was given.

PERRYSBURG WELCOME WAGON: Of course, this no longer exists, but I'm sure a few of us might remember it! Mission purchased \$200.00 of Meijer's gift cards on behalf of the congregation so Pastor Katie and Juan Pablo can stock up their refrigerator, cupboards, or any other needs.

MISSION MEAL: Menu: Chili, cornbread, applesauce, and brownies. Date **moved** to Wednesday, 23rd for Louisiana House and Thursday, 24th Elm House. The Mission team will be providing all food items.

LOOKING AHEAD: One Great Hour of Sharing is a special offering to help Hunger, Disaster, and Development worldwide. Kick off date is March 2, and continues until April 17th.

NOSA GIFT CARDS: Total sales in January was \$2135.00. A lot of THANK YOU'S to all of you!




Selinda Schultz has recently agreed to assume the responsibility of changing the Communion Table cloths pursuant to Presbyterian calendar. Thank you Selinda!
