ADULT BIBLE STUDY



A Fellowship Hour Recipe from the Congregational Life Team:

Blueberry Coffeecake

Cake ingredients:

cup butter
cup sugar
eggs
8 oz container of sour cream
tsp vanilla
cups flour
tsp baking powder
tsp baking soda
21 oz can blueberry pie filling
cup fresh blueberries

Directions:

Cream butter and gradually add sugar, beating until light and fluffy. Add eggs one at a time and beat well after each addition. Stir in sour cream and vanilla. Combine flour, baking powder and baking soda. Gradually add the dry ingredients to the creamed mixture, beating well after each addition. Spread half of the batter in a greased 9"x13" pan. Over this spread the pie filling and berries. Spread the remaining batter over the filling.

Topping:

Combine $\frac{1}{4}$ cup flour and $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of sugar. Cut in 3 Tbsp. of butter until mixture resembles coarse meal. Mix in $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of chopped pecans if desired. Spread the crumble on top of the cake.

Bake in a 375 degree oven for 45 minutes.


