Pastor's Page

Beloved Siblings in Christ,

Grace and peace to you. Here you see a photo from our Blessing of the Animals service on Oct. 4, the feast day of St. Francis of Assisi. We blessed beloved non-human companions, living and dead, who make our lives better because of their presence within them. It was delightful!



As I write this Pastor's Page, I am about to head off for a week away. I'm shuffling notes to myself all over my desk, trying to make sure not to forget anything. It is Fall, after all, that does seem to be the busiest time in the world. I'm going on a week of vacation, how are you tending to yourself? If you are feeling harried by responsibilities, cares and concerns, politics, the environment, anything, step away and recharge. Because there are many important things that need our attention and our wisdom to be at the forefront instead of our fatigue, our fear, or our confusion.

Stewardship Season is about to kick-off here at First Presbyterian Church. Stephen Potts and I are going to be urging you to be mindful of all we do together as a congregation and how we make those things happen together. Our thoughts about stewardship this Fall are swirling around the year-long conversation the Session has been having about God's mission in the world and clarifying our Congregation's mission with God's great mission. We know our mission has to do with showing forth God's love for all people. We know we have gifts and skills in welcome and hospitality. We know from the 2020 CAT Survey that our congregation desires more opportunities for spiritual formation and growth. And we know that the church has to continue to adapt to the rhythms of the community around us. The coming weeks of focus on stewardship and making financial pledges toward our congregation's mission and ministry in 2024 are well worth your attention.

Another thing we have to give careful attention to this Fall is securing new leadership for the Session. Stephen Potts and Jay Salvage will be cycling off of two consecutive 3-year terms. Randy Phillips has moved to the Cleveland area. Jon and Molly's seats stand empty. Did you count on your fingers how many open need to be filled on the Session in 2024? Five. Five seats. It is time for church members to go into your hearts and ask God if you are being called "for such a time as this."* Do you have useful experience and understanding of how churches operate and must be maintained? Are you open to the new things that God is calling us to do and be in our communities? Do you have ideas rolling around in your head and heart that seem right for this moment? Do you have time and ability to consider, decide, and lead together in consensus?

No matter if you are called to congregational leadership at this time or not, we are called together in this congregation to all participate in telling the ongoing story of God moving among us and in this world, the on-going and unfolding story of the urging of the Holy Spirit moving us onward, the grounding and sustaining story of the Kingdom of God that is present here. As disciples of Jesus, we are all called to practice witnessing to his power and redemptive work in the world.
